Executive Summary

The MTJ Foundation's health department successfully carried out a series of medical interventions from July 2024 to February 2025, focusing on underserved communities in Multan, Mian Channu, Tulamba, Toba Tek Singh, and surrounding areas. Through regular medical camps, specialized outreach activities, and free medicine distribution, we addressed critical healthcare needs in these regions

Objectives

Provide free and accessible healthcare services to underserved and vulnerable populations.

- Deliver essential surgical and non-surgical interventions to improve health outcomes.
 - Conduct specialized medical camps to address community-specific health challenges.
 - Reduce the burden of healthcare costs for low-income families through free treatment and medicine distribution.

Monthly Health Data Overview

During this period, the MTJ Foundation treated a cumulative total of **12,236** patients, received **1,520** new applications, and performed **227** surgeries. Improvement rates for surgeries remained consistently high, while a substantial percentage of patients receiving medication also reported improvements.

Key Observations:

- Surgical success rates remained consistently high, ranging from 90% to 96% across all months, with a notable peak of 96% in both December 2024 and January 2025.
 - Medicine efficacy showed gradual improvement throughout the reporting period, with up to 75% of cases showing significant improvement in January 2025.
 - Over PKR 16.18 million worth of free medicine was distributed across all regions during the reporting period.

Next Steps

- Increase the frequency of specialized medical camps in underserved areas.
 - Enhance data collection and real-time reporting on patient outcomes.
 - Explore partnerships with additional hospitals and specialists to expand outreach capacity.

By providing consultations, surgeries, and free medicine, these interventions have reduced health inequities and enhanced the overall well-being of beneficiaries.
